Murtadha visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child was assessed by Ostathna. During the evaluation, he presented with **information processing delays and global developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism** as well as **features of intellectual developmental delays**. These findings indicate that the current challenges are functional and developmental in nature, and the child requires further targeted analysis to fully understand the contributing biological and physiological factors.

At this stage, the child would benefit from a structured developmental protocol and deeper investigations to identify underlying causes affecting processing, cognition, and overall developmental progress.

This assessment is not a final diagnosis but a developmental evaluation based on current observations.

Recommended Plan**1. Development Protocol for Information Processing**

- Continue with the tailored developmental protocol for **4 months**, followed by a full reassessment (preferably in person).
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a new baseline after the 4-month cycle.
- Continue with the intervention plan as the child progresses.

2. Recommended Tests on a Regular Basis (Through Neurazon – Canada)

These tests aim to identify underlying biomedical, genetic, and physiological contributors to the child's developmental profile. The analyses are external and not done through our center.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (intensive, to begin in later stages after determining the primary causes)

Notes on External Testing

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These tests are **external, optional, and not performed directly through our center**. They are suggested to support a deeper understanding of the child's developmental profile. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information.

The recommended tests are external and optional.
