### Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

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### Overview:

Lamees Farran visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation showed **significant improvement following the first protocol**, demonstrating notable developmental progress. However, ongoing observations reveal **information processing delays and developmental delays**, leading to **acquired features of autism and hyperlexia-like traits**.

These findings are consistent with the results of the **Precision Health Analysis conducted by Neurazon (Canada)**, which identified a **variant affecting brain development** and contributing to the child's learning and processing profile. Further analysis is recommended to refine the intervention strategy and ensure sustained progress.

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### Recommended Plan:

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the current individualized protocol for **4 months**, followed by a **re-evaluation**, preferably in person.
- Establish a clear developmental baseline to measure further progress.
- Maintain structured and targeted **intervention activities** throughout this period.

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#### 2) Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada)

##### Neuronal Growth Factors Analysis – Neurazon (Canada)

- Provides an in-depth analysis of the body's ability to absorb and utilize key neuronal growth elements essential for brain and white matter development.
- **Sample Type:** Hair
- **Processing Time:** Approximately **2 months (business days)**

- Recommended to be **repeated every 6–12 months** to monitor absorption patterns and track long-term improvement.

### 3) Recommended Therapy (after determining the causes)

- **Neuroplasticity Therapy (Intensive):** To be initiated **as soon as possible** to strengthen cognitive and processing networks.
- **Rehabilitation Therapy and School:** Continue therapies and academic engagement in **Saudi Arabia**, ensuring consistent developmental and educational support.

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. These tests are **external and not performed directly through our center**. They are **recommendations**, not obligations, designed to support a deeper understanding of the child's developmental profile.
