

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdallah was evaluated at our center due to concerns regarding his developmental trajectory. The assessment findings revealed **Information Processing Delay** and **Intellectual Developmental Delays** that have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. These features are not considered classical autism but rather acquired traits resulting from delays that can be targeted and improved with the appropriate intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Non-Chemical Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a customized, non-pharmaceutical development protocol
- Continue the plan for **4 months**, followed by in-person reevaluation
- Establish a clear baseline and measure improvement against this
- Maintain consistent therapy sessions throughout the intervention period

2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):

Note: Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are conducted through Neurazon (Canada) and are not carried out at our center. Results support intervention planning.

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**
 - To begin in later stages depending on progress
- **Occupational and Rehabilitation Speech Therapy**
 - Should be pursued regularly in the child's home country
 - Focus areas include expressive/receptive language, motor coordination, and cognitive function


