Overview:

Sanad-Nemer Younis was assessed at our center on 29-07-2025. The evaluation revealed information processing delays and developmental delays that have led to Hyperlexia 3. The child does not currently score as a case of autism but presents with minimal features of autism due to these developmental delays. With targeted interventions and proper support, the child is open to significant improvement in the future.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Follow the protocol for 4 months.
 - Reevaluate the child in person after 4 months.
 - Establish a baseline and continue with the intervention plan as needed.

2. Main Recommended Analysis:

- Further analyses may be considered after the next evaluation to better understand underlying factors.
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3. Recommended Therapy:

- Additional therapy recommendations will be provided after the next assessment based on the child's progress and developmental response.

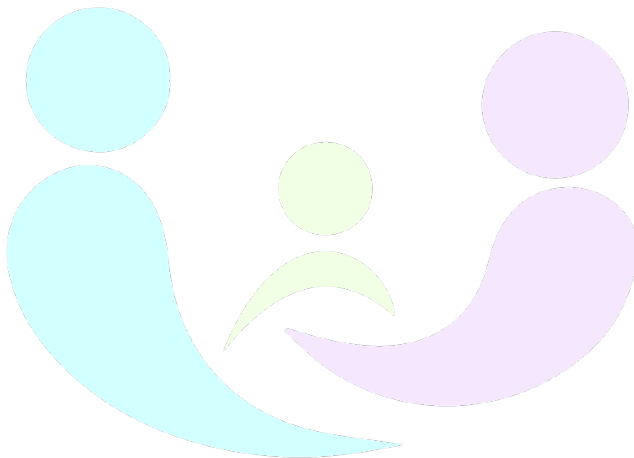
