

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 23-06-2025

Child's Name: Tamim Yazan Elmanseer

Date of Birth: 24-08-2020

Overview:

Tamim was assessed at our center due to concerns regarding **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which are currently contributing to **learning difficulties**. However, Tamim **does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder**. Further developmental assessment is recommended to understand the contributing factors in more detail.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Initiate a structured development protocol for a duration of **4 months**
 - **Reevaluation in person** is advised at the end of the 4-month period
 - Establish a developmental baseline
 - Modify and continue the intervention plan based on progress
2. **Recommended Tests:**
 - Testing to be determined **based on findings from the next evaluation**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - Therapeutic plan (e.g., speech, occupational, or mitotherapy) to be finalized **following further assessment**

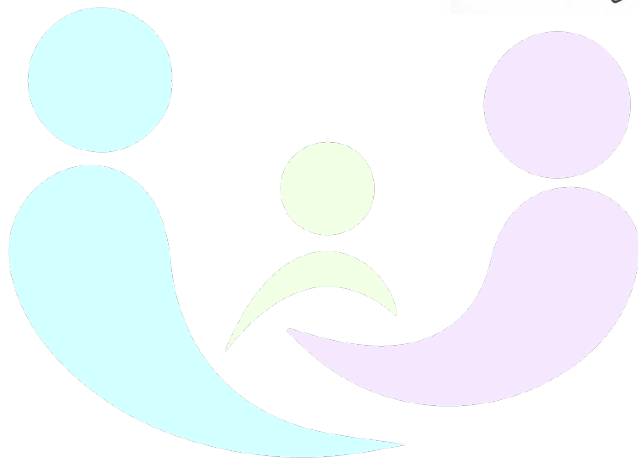
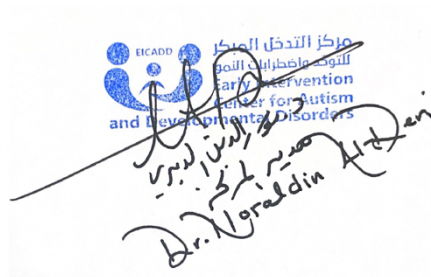
