Overview

Rayan visited our center for a follow-up developmental progress assessment. The evaluation showed information-processing delays and developmental delays due to variants affecting brain development.

Rayan demonstrated **significant improvement under the first intervention protocol**, indicating the importance of **continuous**, **uninterrupted intervention**.

He still presents acquired features of autism related to his developmental delays.

Recommended Plan



1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the current protocol for 4 months, then reassess, preferably in-person.
- At reassessment, establish a **new baseline** to adjust the plan as needed.
- Maintain consistent intervention without interruption.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

Note: The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide.

These are **suggestions**, **not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly through our centers**. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for more details.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity rehabilitation therapy** (to be continued in Jordan after occupational therapy and sensory-integration sessions).
- Speech Therapy: 3 sessions per week.
- Occupational Therapy: 3 sessions per week.
- Occupational Therapy / Light Therapy: 2 sessions per week Gamma (> 30 Hz only).

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Conclusion

This assessment reflects Rayan's current developmental status and guides the next phase of intervention. His progress confirms the benefit of ongoing therapy without pauses, and further gains are expected with continued adherence to the recommended protocol and therapies.
