

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Sheikha was assessed at our center and was found to have **information processing delays** as well as **regressive developmental delays**, which have contributed to signs of **intellectual developmental delay**, **cognitive delays**, and **minor features of acquired autism**. However, it is important to note that the child **does not meet the criteria for a formal autism diagnosis** at this time. Further analysis and intervention are recommended to clarify the root causes and support ongoing improvement.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person)
 - Establish a developmental baseline
 - Continue with the individualized intervention plan
2. **Recommended Laboratory Analyses (via Neurazon – Canada):**

Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.

3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity rehabilitation** (2–3 sessions per week), to begin **as soon as possible**, preferably within the next **two months or earlier** if available.

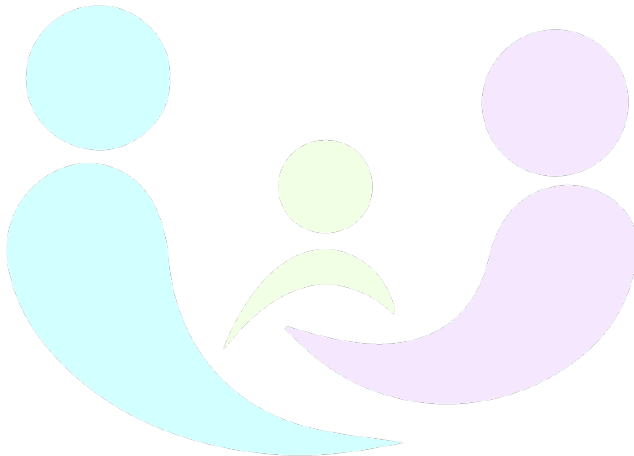

