



## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Ahmad Al Badawi was assessed at our center on May 26th, 2025. The child shows evident **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that have led to **acquired features of autism**. Notably, there has been **improvement since the last assessment**, especially in general responsiveness and certain behavioral areas. However, key autism features are still present and require continued monitoring and targeted intervention. To understand the remaining delays and plan the next phase of therapy, further analysis is recommended.

### Recommended Plan:

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with the current developmental protocol for an additional **4 months**
- Conduct a **reevaluation in person** at the end of this period
- Establish a clear developmental and cognitive baseline
- Adjust the therapeutic approach based on the child's ongoing progress

#### 2) Main Recommended Analysis (Conducted through Neurazon – Canada):

### 3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Mitotherapy Therapy (Intensive Protocol):** To support cellular and neurological health
- **Speech Therapy (ST):** 2 sessions per week
- **Occupational Therapy (OT):** 2 sessions per week
- If remote support is needed, a **customized therapy plan** can be provided for at-home implementation
