Assessment Overview

Obada was assessed at Ostathna Center for ongoing developmental follow-up. The child has shown great improvement on the first protocol, indicating strong developmental potential. During the evaluation, Obada demonstrated information processing delays and developmental delays that contribute to learning difficulties. Although he displays acquired features of autism, he does not score as a case of autism. His profile is more consistent with developmental delays with high potential for continued progress.

Further analysis will be needed in future stages to better understand the full biological and developmental contributors once the next reassessment is completed.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the development protocol for **4 months**.
- Reevaluate the child in person after 4 months.
- Establish an updated baseline after reassessment.
- Continue with the intervention plan to support developmental and cognitive gains.

2) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes

- Speech Therapy (ST) and Occupational Therapy (OT) on a monthly structured plan.
- Increase intensity depending on progress after reevaluation.

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (**Canada**), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited laboratories worldwide. These tests are **external**, **optional**, and **not performed** directly through Ostathna Center.
