Overview

Rashed Hassan Al-Ali attended a follow-up developmental assessment at EICADD Center Ajman. Based on the current evaluation and review of prior intervention, the child presents with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to **hyperlexia closer to Hyperlexia Type 2** (acquired features consistent with autism).

The child has shown marked improvement following the first development protocol, indicating good responsiveness to intervention. Despite this progress, continued structured support and targeted monitoring remain necessary to consolidate gains and guide further development.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the development protocol for **4 months**, followed by **re-evaluation**, preferably **in person**.
- Reassess progress to establish an updated baseline and refine improvement projections.
- Continue with the current intervention plan to support sustained developmental gains.

Recommended Therapy

Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy

• Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week

• Status: Continue according to the current plan

Rashed has demonstrated **significant improvement** following the initial development protocol, supporting the presence of modifiable, acquired developmental features rather than a fixed condition. Continued intervention, alongside targeted growth-factor analysis, is recommended to further enhance information processing, language integration, and adaptive functioning. Ongoing reassessment will allow refinement of the plan based on objective progress.
