Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Kareem was assessed through a developmental evaluation. The child presents with **information processing delays and developmental delays** that have resulted in **acquired features of autism**, although **he does not score as a case of autism at this stage**. Early and structured intervention is strongly recommended to prevent progression and to support brain development during this critical neuroplastic phase.

Further analyses are recommended to better understand the underlying biological factors contributing to these delays.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for 4 months, then schedule an in-person reassessment
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a new baseline at that time.
- Continue with the structured intervention plan.
- 2) Recommended Tests Through Neurazon (Canada) (External, optional, and not conducted directly through our center)
- 3) Recommended Therapy

Rehabilitation & Neuroplasticity Program

To begin gradually, then intensified in later stages:

- Plasticity Therapy (later stages)
- Occupational Therapy (OT): 2 sessions per week
- Speech Therapy (ST): 2 sessions per week
- Mito Therapy / Light Therapy (LT): 2 sessions per week

A combination of developmental, behavioural, and sensory-motor approaches is recommended to support progress across cognition, language, and functional skills.

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Notes on External Testing

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories.

These analyses are **external**, **optional**, and **not performed directly through EICADD Center**. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for additional details.

This assessment is **not** a **final diagnosis** but a developmental evaluation based on current findings. Kareem is capable of improvement, and results may change with continued intervention and targeted therapy.
