

**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Assessment Summary:**

The child presents with **information processing delay**, **features of autism**, and **intellectual developmental delays**. These observations were made during an in-person evaluation. Although the child does not score definitively as a case of classical autism, the acquired features suggest the need for structured intervention and ongoing monitoring.

**Recommended Plan:**

**1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:**

- Duration: **3–4 months**
- Reevaluate the child at the end of the period, preferably in person
- Goal: Establish a baseline, monitor improvement, and adjust therapeutic strategies accordingly
- Continued sessions of therapy are essential to support processing and cognitive development

**2. Recommended Tests:**

- No immediate testing required
- Future tests may be needed depending on progress and outcomes during the next evaluation phase

**Conclusion:**

This is a developmental assessment conducted for early intervention and planning purposes. Ameer is capable of progress with targeted therapy. Recommendations are shared in line with Neurazon guidance and do not represent a final medical diagnosis.
