

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Lina was assessed at our center and presents with **information processing delays, developmental delays, and acquired features of autism**. These features appear to be secondary to her prior medical history of **citrullinemia**, which was treated with a **liver transplant** one year ago. Although her underlying metabolic condition is now resolved, the child continues to display developmental challenges that require structured support. Further analysis is recommended to understand and address remaining neurological needs.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing**
 - Duration: 4 months
 - In-person reassessment is recommended afterward
 - Establish a baseline and adapt interventions as needed
2. **Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):**
 - **Please refer to their report and assessment.**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (when available in UAE or Jordan)
 - **Mitotherapy** during the summer (2 light therapy sessions), followed by continued sessions in **Ajman, UAE**
 - **Speech Therapy (ST):** 2 sessions per week
 - **Occupational Therapy (OT):** 1–2 sessions per week


