
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Karam Faisel Ali visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicated the presence of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have contributed to **speech delays** and other aspects of developmental progression. These findings suggest that the child's challenges stem primarily from delays in cognitive processing and communication integration rather than a structural neurological disorder.

Karam shows good potential for improvement with structured intervention and continuous monitoring. Further analysis is recommended to identify possible biological or environmental factors influencing these delays and to tailor future therapeutic protocols accordingly.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the **developmental protocol** for 4 months, followed by a comprehensive in-person reevaluation.
 - Reassess progress and establish a baseline for comparison in subsequent visits.
 - Maintain ongoing sessions under the current intervention framework.
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2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Rehabilitation Therapy – Plasticity Therapy:** Intensive sessions to begin in later stages, focused on enhancing brain plasticity, processing speed, and connectivity.
- **Rehabilitation Therapy (Ongoing):** Continue current intervention focusing on speech, communication, and general developmental milestones.


