Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Shabib was assessed at our center on 08-09-2025. The evaluation revealed information processing delays and developmental delays that have led to acquired features of autism. These findings suggest the need for further analyses to understand the underlying causes and to provide a more tailored intervention plan. Despite these challenges, Shabib demonstrates the capacity for improvement with structured intervention and supportive therapies.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Implement a structured 4-month developmental protocol targeting information processing.
- Reevaluate after 4 months, preferably in person.
- Establish a baseline during reevaluation to track measurable progress.
- Continue with the intervention plan, adjusting as needed.

2. Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada):

The recommended tests are external and conducted through Neurazon (Canada). These are optional recommendations provided to gain deeper insights and are not obligatory. They are not performed directly through our centers but serve as supportive measures for more targeted planning. Please refer to their report and assessment.

3. Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy** is recommended in **later stages**, once Shabib is ready for intensive sessions. This therapy will be important for improving cognitive processing, communication, and adaptive skills.

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Conclusion:

Shabib presents with developmental and information processing delays, leading to acquired features of autism. With structured intervention, external analyses, and future therapies, he has the potential to make significant progress. Close monitoring and reassessment in 4 months will be essential to guide his developmental trajectory.
