#### **Overview:**

Kareem Akram Abdalla was assessed at our center on June 3rd, 2025. The evaluation identified **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, contributing to the emergence of **hyperlexia 2**, which is typically seen in children with features of **high-functioning autism**. While these features are present, further analysis is needed to fully understand the underlying causes and to design a targeted intervention plan.

### **Recommended Plan:**

### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing



- Begin a 4-month non-chemical developmental protocol, with a focus on enhancing cognitive flexibility, language comprehension, and early literacy skills.
- Conduct an **in-person reassessment** after 4 months to establish a new baseline and monitor progress.
- Continue adapting the plan based on Kareem's response and developmental trajectory.

### 2) Main Recommended Analysis (Conducted Through Neurazon – Canada):

**Please refer to their report.** These tests are optional and are conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada), designed to create a precision-based treatment strategy.

## 3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Intensive):
  - o To begin **after 4 months**, contingent on the results of the reevaluation and further analysis.







- Therapies in the Child's Home Country:
  - o **Speech Therapy** and **Occupational Therapy** are recommended to strengthen communication, adaptive behavior, and fine motor skills.
