Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Mohamed was assessed at our center on 03-09-2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to **hyperlexia type 3**, a condition that is **closer to typical development** and does **not score as a case of autism**. While Mohamed demonstrates positive developmental characteristics, further analyses are needed to better understand underlying factors and support his ongoing progress.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Apply a **4-month developmental protocol** focusing on information processing.
- Conduct a **reevaluation after 4 months**, preferably in person.
- Establish a **baseline** for progress measurement.
- Continue and adapt the intervention plan as necessary.

2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada)

 - **Frequency:** Every 6–12 months.

3) Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy:** Intensive program recommended to **start as soon as possible** to maximize cognitive and developmental outcomes.

Conclusion

Mohamed presents with **hyperlexia type 3, closer to typical development**, without meeting the criteria for autism. His profile shows potential for continued improvement with structured intervention. Regular therapy, combined with detailed analyses through Neurazon, will provide greater insight into his needs and guide the most effective developmental plan.

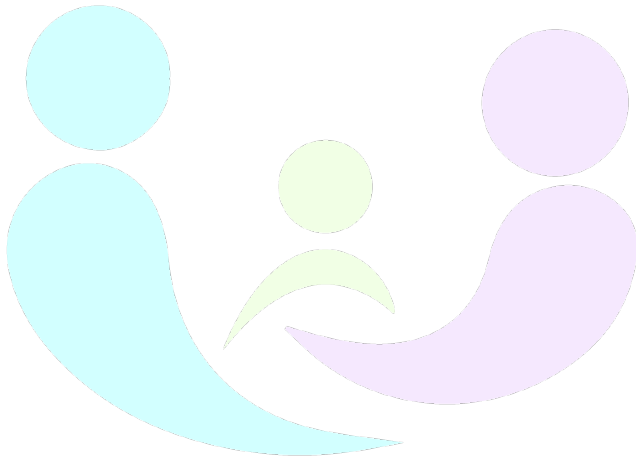
