Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Leyan was assessed at our center to evaluate his developmental and cognitive progress. The results indicate **information processing delays**, **cognitive developmental delays**, and the presence of **acquired features of autism**. These features appear to be secondary to the underlying delays rather than indicative of true autism. At this stage, a final diagnosis is not determined, and further assessments are necessary to better understand the contributing factors and support a tailored intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- o Initiate a focused intervention program targeting information processing delays for 4 months.
- o A reassessment is recommended after 4 months, ideally in person.
- Ouring this time, establish a developmental baseline and continue refining the plan based on Leyan's progress.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. Please note that these are recommendations and not obligatory, and they are not conducted through our centers directly.

3. Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- o Speech Therapy (ST): 2 sessions per week
- o Occupational Therapy (OT): 2 sessions per week
- o Mitotherapy (Light Therapy): 2 sessions per week
- o **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** Intensive program to be conducted in the UAE or when available in Jordan
