Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Hasan-Ali visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates that the child presents with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have resulted in **learning difficulties and slower cognitive processing**. Despite these challenges, Hasan-Ali demonstrates **strong potential for improvement** and is responsive to structured interventions and guided developmental plans.

The current findings suggest that the child would benefit from a continued and personalized intervention protocol, along with deeper biological analyses to identify underlying causes and guide a targeted rehabilitation program.

Recommended Plan



1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured **Development Protocol** for a period of **4 months**, followed by a **reevaluation**, preferably conducted **in person**.
- Reassess developmental milestones and establish a **baseline** to monitor measurable progress.
- Maintain consistent engagement in educational and cognitive training activities at home to support neuroplasticity and learning stability.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

The recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)** — a bioinformatics company partnering with certified laboratories across Canada, Turkey, Spain, and the USA. These tests are **external and optional**, not conducted directly through EICADD centers. Results will provide valuable data to refine the intervention plan and ensure individualized precision health support.

3) Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Intensive):**
Focused on improving cognitive flexibility, memory retention, and adaptive processing speed through neuroplasticity-based training.
- **Supplementary Home-Based Training:**
Encourage activities that enhance fine motor coordination, pattern recognition, and logical reasoning.
Regular reading comprehension and problem-solving exercises should also be implemented to strengthen learning pathways.
