

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Omar was assessed at our center for developmental progress. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have contributed to **behavioral challenges** and **speech developmental delays**. These findings are linked to **variants affecting brain development**, and Omar also exhibits **hyperlexia-like features**. The child requires further analyses to clarify underlying biological and physiological contributors.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

1. Continue with a structured developmental protocol addressing information processing challenges.
2. Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
3. Reassess baseline at reevaluation and adapt the plan as needed.
4. Maintain consistency with the current intervention plan.

2. Main Recommended Analyses

The recommended **Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis** is conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**. This is an external test and not performed directly at our centers. Results will be shared with the guardian once available. Please refer to their report and assessment.

3. Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** Intensive sessions to begin as soon as possible, aimed at supporting cognitive, behavioral, and speech-related improvements.

Conclusion

This assessment indicates that Omar presents with information processing delays, speech and behavioral developmental delays, and hyperlexia-like features. With targeted therapy, structured developmental protocols, and further analyses, Omar remains open for improvement. Early intervention and ongoing monitoring are critical to maximizing developmental progress.
