Overview:

Soufian was evaluated due to **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that have led to **acquired features of autism**. The assessment indicates the need for further analysis to understand the underlying causes and refine the intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

- 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - Implement a non-chemical protocol for information processing delays.
 - Conduct this protocol for 4 months, followed by an in-person reassessment.
 - Establish a baseline for progress tracking and make adjustments as needed.
- 2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon Canada):

Please refer to their assessment. These analyses are external, provided through Neurazon (Canada), and not conducted at our center.

- 3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:
 - Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: Start in later stages (not immediately).
 - **Speech and Occupational Therapy:** 2 sessions each (2ST and 2OT) to improve communication, sensory integration, and functional development.
