Assessment Summary:

Eliana Iyad Alhajhasan was assessed at our center due to concerns regarding developmental milestones and communication skills. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. Although the child shows signs commonly seen in autism, these are not due to a core autism diagnosis but rather acquired as a result of the underlying delays.

Further biomedical and functional analysis is necessary to determine the root causes and guide an effective intervention strategy tailored to Eliana's needs.

Recommended Plan:

EICADD

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Implement a focused protocol to enhance cognitive processing and sensory integration.
- Duration: **4 months**, followed by **in-person reassessment** to evaluate progress.
- Reestablish the developmental baseline and continue with the adjusted intervention plan accordingly.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy (Post-Analysis):

- **Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):**
 - Frequency: 1–2 sessions per week
- **Speech Therapy (ST):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week
- **Occupational Therapy (OT):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week

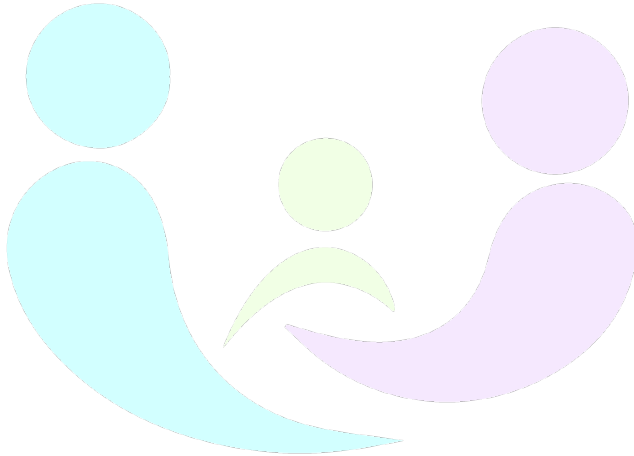


