Assessment Summary:

Hamza was assessed on 25-06-2025 and showed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. Notably, despite improvements in several developmental areas, the child showed **regression in speech and vision**, indicating the need for **neuroplasticity-based interventions**. These signs reinforce the need for further biomedical and neurodevelopmental assessment.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing



- Continue the current developmental protocol
- Reassess after 4 months, preferably in person
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a new baseline
- Continue or adjust the intervention plan based on progress

2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):

- Precision Health Analysis
 - o A detailed review of physiological and genetic factors contributing to delays
 - Saliva sample
 - o Results in 4 months (business days)
- Functional Urine Analysis
 - o To evaluate internal absorption and detoxification function
 - Urine sample
 - o Results in 4 months (business days)
 - o Repeated every 6–12 months

After 4 months of supplementation:







- Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis
 - o Further insight into nutrient utilization and neuronal support
 - Hair sample
 - o Results in 2 months (business days)
 - o Repeated every 6–12 months

3. Recommended Therapy after Determining the Causes:

- Mitotherapy (2 light therapy sessions per week)
- Speech Therapy: 2 sessions per week
- Occupational Therapy: 2 sessions per week
- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: 2 sessions per week (once available in Jordan)
