

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Anzor Mohammad Sain was assessed at our center on May 24th, 2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, with emerging characteristics of **hyperlexia**, closer to **Hyperlexia Type 3**, although not fully meeting the criteria at this time. These delays are affecting the child's ability to integrate and interpret complex information in an age-appropriate manner.

Further analysis is needed to determine the biological and neurological factors contributing to these developmental challenges, in order to implement a more targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan:

- Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Implement the protocol for **4 months**, with consistent follow-up
 - Reevaluate the child **in person** after this period to assess progress
 - Adjust and **personalize** the intervention based on updated findings
- Main Recommended Analysis (through Neurazon – Canada):**

- Recommended Therapy (Post-Analysis):**
 - Mitotherapy Therapy** – 2 to 3 sessions per week
 - Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** – To begin in later stages based on readiness
 - Speech Therapy (ST)** – 2 sessions per week
 - Occupational Therapy (OT)** – 2 sessions per week
