Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdulaziz Baitishaq was assessed through an **in person evaluation**, during which he displayed clear signs of **information processing delays**, **intellectual developmental delays**, and **acquired features of autism**. These features appear to be secondary to underlying physiological or neurological imbalances that require further investigation.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing
 - o Initiate a tailored intervention program focused on cognitive processing and intellectual development.
 - O Duration: 4 months, followed by a reevaluation preferably in person to observe changes directly.
 - Establish a clear developmental baseline and track measurable improvements over time.
 - o Continue with therapy and supportive strategies aimed at reversing acquired features.
- 2. Recommended Therapy (Post-Test):
 - After test results are received and reviewed, initiate **Intensive Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation**Therapy to stimulate targeted brain networks responsible for cognition, communication, and adaptive behavior.

Conclusion:

This report represents a **preliminary assessment** of Abdulaziz's neurodevelopmental status. While signs of acquired autism and intellectual delay are present, they appear to be **modifiable** through biomedical investigation and targeted intervention. The child should be reassessed in person following the outlined testing to develop a finalized and individualized therapy plan. This is not a final medical doagnosis, it is a devleopmental analysis for rehabilitation purposes.
