

Overview:

Reham and Mariam Fahad Shebeeb Al Juweisri, identical twins, were assessed at our center for developmental progress. Both children present with significant information processing delays and features of cognitive developmental delays. These delays have led to acquired features that resemble autism. These features appear to be the result of functional and cognitive challenges rather than genetic autism. Further assessment is necessary to clarify the underlying causes and to guide targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan:



- o Begin a non-medicinal, structured protocol for both children, customized to their processing and cognitive profiles.
- o Maintain this protocol for 4 months.
- Reevaluate both children in person to measure progress and reestablish their developmental baseline.
- o Adjust and continue the intervention plan based on the follow-up assessment.
- 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3. Recommended Therapy:

- Speech and Occupational Therapy (in their home country):
 - Should be started promptly and maintained consistently to support communication and functional development.
- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:
 - Begin as soon as possible to stimulate brain adaptability and support both cognitive and behavioral improvement.
