Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Mohammad was assessed at our center as part of ongoing monitoring for developmental progress. The evaluation showed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which initially contributed to **acquired features of autism**. However, it is important to note that **this is not a case of true autism**, and the child has already shown **significant improvement** since starting early intervention. The case remains **open to further improvement**, and ongoing therapy is expected to yield continued positive outcomes.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- o Continue the tailored developmental protocol for 4 to 6 months.
- o Conduct a full reevaluation after this period, ideally in person.
- o Reassess the child's progress, establish a new baseline, and continue with a refined therapy plan based on improvements.

2. Recommended Analysis:

3. Recommended Therapy Plan:

- o Speech Therapy (ST): 2 sessions per week
- o Occupational Therapy (OT): 2 sessions per week
- o Light Therapy (LT/Mitotherapy): 2 sessions per week
- o Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: Intensive therapy block in the UAE
