

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Assessment

Rami visited our center for a developmental evaluation on 27-04-2025.

The assessment findings revealed:

- **Information Processing Delays**
- **Developmental Delays**
- **Acquired features of Autism**, but the child does **not meet the criteria** for a formal diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder at this stage.

The child was assessed **in person**, and further in-depth analysis is required to determine the underlying causes and optimize the future intervention plan.

This assessment represents a developmental and functional analysis for intervention planning purposes and is not considered a medical diagnosis. Rami shows potential for meaningful improvement with early and structured intervention.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate targeted therapy sessions to strengthen cognitive processing, sensory integration, and communication abilities.
- **Duration:** 4 months
- **Reevaluation:** Preferably in person after 4 months to reassess progress and adapt interventions based on outcomes.
- **Goal:** Improve information processing capabilities, language development, and overall developmental functioning.

2) Main Recommended Analysis

- **Precision Health Analysis (through Neurazon – Canada):**
A comprehensive analysis designed to identify potential genetic, metabolic, or functional contributors to the developmental profile.
Sample: Saliva
Turnaround Time: 4 months business days.

3) Main Recommended Therapy

- **Occupational Therapy Plan:**
Focused on sensory processing, fine motor coordination, and enhancing readiness for learning and communication tasks.
- **Speech Therapy Plan:**
Addressing receptive and expressive language development, social communication skills, and early language foundations.
- **Technology Therapy:**
Incorporating technology-assisted sensory stimulation and cognitive training tools to support brain development, including:
 - Light therapy
 - Sensory regulation technologies
 - Early learning communication systems

Follow-Up Plan

- **Reassessment:**
After 4 months to evaluate the effectiveness of the intervention and to determine necessary updates to the therapy plan.
- **Continuous Monitoring:**
Progress should be carefully tracked through therapy session notes, therapist reports, and parental observations.
- **Important Note:**
This evaluation is based on developmental and functional observations and is not a final medical diagnosis. Continued structured intervention will be essential for optimizing Rami's developmental outcomes.


