Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Muayed Hamid Mohamed Fraish Al Wahaibi visited our center for a developmental evaluation. The assessment identified information processing delays, cognitive developmental delay features, and intellectual developmental delays. These factors have contributed to acquired features resembling autism; however, they do not reflect a definitive case of Autism Spectrum Disorder. The delays appear to be driven by underlying neurological and functional causes that require further investigation and consistent intervention.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Implement a structured, individualized developmental protocol.
 - Continue this approach for 4 months.
 - o Reevaluate the child after this period, preferably in person, to establish a new baseline and monitor progress.
 - Adjust the intervention plan accordingly based on observed improvements and findings.
- 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and assessment.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - Speech and Occupational Therapy (in Oman):
 - These therapies should begin promptly and be tailored to support communication, processing, and daily functional skills.
 - Coordination with local providers in Oman is essential for consistency and effective implementation.
