### **Overview:**

Hamza-Mohammad was assessed at our center and presents with information processing delays and developmental delays. These have resulted in acquired features of autism, presenting as hyperlexia that is currently closer to Hyperlexia Type 2, with a trajectory toward Type 3 if guided with appropriate intervention. The child does not currently meet the criteria for classical autism, and further targeted analysis is necessary to understand the underlying causes.

#### **Recommended Plan:**

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing
  - Duration: 4 months
  - In-person reassessment recommended
  - Establish baseline and adjust based on response
- 2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon Canada):

- 3. Recommended Therapy (Post-Test):
  - o **Mitotherapy**: 2–3 light therapy sessions weekly
  - o Occupational Therapy (OT): 2 sessions weekly
  - Neuroplasticity Therapy Intensive
