

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 12-06-2025

Child's Name: Nour Buareki

Date of Birth: 14-03-2022

Overview:

Nour Buareki was assessed at our center on 12-06-2025. During the evaluation, Nour presented with **information processing delays, developmental delays, and acquired features of autism**. These delays indicate challenges in how the child processes sensory and cognitive information and in overall age-appropriate developmental milestones. The observed features of autism appear to be acquired and may be influenced by underlying physiological or environmental factors. Further investigation is necessary to understand the root causes of these delays.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Begin a structured developmental intervention protocol focusing on improving Nour's processing and cognitive response.
 - Duration: 4 months.
 - A follow-up evaluation is recommended at the end of this period (preferably in person) to assess progress and establish a new baseline.
 - Continue the plan with modifications as needed based on the reassessment.
2. **Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):**
 - **Please refer to their report and assessment.**
3. **Recommended Therapy (after identifying root causes):**
 - Start **neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy intensively** as soon as the results are reviewed and causes are clarified.
 - This therapy is designed to stimulate brain development, promote neural connectivity, and support improved cognitive and behavioral functioning.

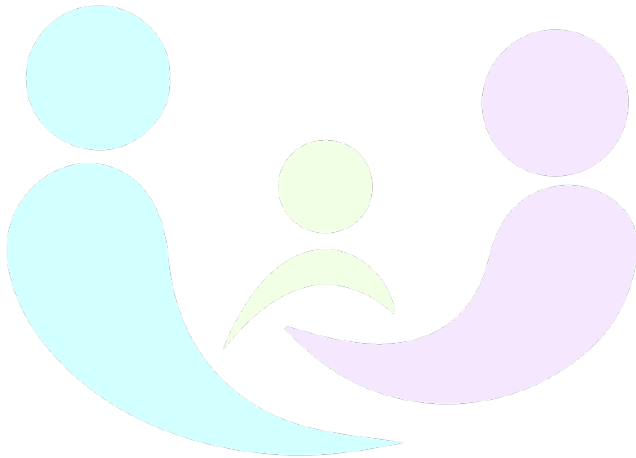
