Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Farouq visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicated **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays** that have led to **hyperlexia closer to Hyperlexia 2**, presenting as **acquired features of high-functioning autism**.

In addition, Farouq exhibits social and behavioural delays. A previous risk of epileptic episodes was reported but has been successfully resolved with medication. Ongoing monitoring is advised to ensure that no recurrence develops. Further analyses are recommended to gain a deeper understanding of contributing factors.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement the protocol for **4 months**, after which Farouq should be **re-evaluated in person**.
- Re-establish a **baseline** during the follow-up visit.
- Continue the **intervention plan** consistently to maintain progress.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. These tests are recommendations and not obligatory, and they are **not** conducted directly through our center.

3) Recommended Therapy:

- Plasticity rehabilitation therapy: Intensive program.
- Occupational Therapy & Speech Therapy: 2 sessions per week each.

Conclusion:

This assessment is **not** a **final diagnosis** but reflects the child's **current developmental profile**. Farouq is **capable of improvement**, and findings may change as he responds to consistent interventions.
