
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Saif Al Naiser was reassessed at our center following the completion of his initial developmental intervention protocol. The child has shown significant improvement, with only minimal remaining information processing delays and minimal developmental delays. These delays appear to be linked to underlying genetic variants previously identified.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue with the current protocol for an additional 4 months.
- A follow-up, preferably in person, is advised at the end of the 4-month period.
- The goal is to reevaluate Saif's baseline, monitor his progress, and further reduce the minimal delays noted.

2. Recommended Tests by and through Neurazon (Canada):

- At this stage, no immediate testing is required.
- They may determine the need for additional testing based on findings during the next evaluation.

3. Recommended Therapy:

- Intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy is to be continued to support further gains in processing and developmental capacity.
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Conclusion:

Saif Al Naiser has responded very well to intervention. Continued support is expected to bring about full developmental alignment. Reassessment in 4 months will be key to determine further needs. This is not a final diagnosis but an assessment open to change based on the child's ongoing development.
