#### Overview

Abdulaziz visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. During the evaluation, he presented with **Information Processing Delays** and **global cognitive developmental delays**. These delays are contributing to **acquired features of autism**, primarily driven by the disruptions in processing speed, integration of information, and higher-order cognitive functions. The child currently requires **urgent and structured intervention**, as delays at this stage can accumulate rapidly without timely support. This assessment is not a final diagnosis but reflects Abdulaziz's current developmental profile based on observed patterns and standardized evaluation procedures. With proper intervention and targeted therapy, improvements are expected.

#### Recommended Plan

##### 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Apply the protocol for **4 months**, followed by reevaluation, preferably in person.
- Establish a clear **baseline** and adjust the intervention plan based on documented progress.
- Continue with the structured developmental intervention program.

##### 2. Main Recommended Analyses (Through Neurazon – Canada)

**The recommended tests are conducted through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. These are recommendations, not obligatory, and they are not conducted directly through our centers.**

##### 3. Recommended Therapy

###### A. Rehabilitation Therapy

- **Occupational Therapy (OT) and Speech Therapy (ST)**  
Continue regularly to address cognitive, sensory-motor, communication, and functional deficits.

###### B. Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy

- To be initiated in **later stages** once readiness is confirmed.
- Not recommended at this stage of development until foundational processing abilities improve.

#### Notes on External Testing

All analyses listed above are performed exclusively through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics center partnered with internationally accredited laboratories. These are **optional** recommendations intended to provide deeper insights into Abdulaziz's neurodevelopmental profile. They are **not performed directly through EICADD Center**.
