Overview

Khamis was assessed at our center on 04-09-2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays and intellectual developmental delays** leading to **features of autism**. These findings indicate challenges in learning, cognitive processing, and adaptive development. However, Khamis demonstrates potential for improvement with structured therapeutic support and targeted interventions. Further analyses are necessary to better understand the underlying causes and guide his developmental plan.

Recommended Plan



1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Implement a 4-month structured developmental protocol targeting information processing.
- Conduct a reevaluation after 4 months, preferably in person.
- Establish a **baseline** during reevaluation to measure progress.
- Continue and adapt the intervention plan as needed.

2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada)

The recommended analyses are coordinated through **Neurazon (Canada)**. These are **recommendations**, **not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly through our centers**. 3) Therapy

- **Speech and Occupational Therapy:** To be conducted locally in Oman to address communication, adaptive functioning, and daily living skills.
- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: Recommended for later stages once the child is ready, focusing on strengthening brain connectivity and information processing.

Conclusion

Khamis presents with intellectual developmental delays, information processing delays, and features of autism. With structured therapy and the recommended analyses, there is potential to enhance his communication, academic skills, and adaptive behavior. Consistent follow-up and intervention are key to supporting his developmental progress. A reevaluation in 4 months is strongly recommended.
