

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Aon was assessed for developmental functioning. Findings indicate **information processing delays** with **intellectual developmental delays** leading to **features of autism**. The child **requires immediate intervention** to support learning and daily functioning. **Further analyses** are recommended to clarify contributing biological factors and to optimize the intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin a structured protocol for **4 months** (attention, processing speed, working memory, comprehension).
- **Reevaluate in person** after 4 months to establish a clear baseline and recalibrate goals.
- Continue and adapt the intervention according to measured progress.

2) Main Recommended Analyses

- **According to the next evaluation**, additional analyses may be requested based on readiness and clinical priorities.

3) Therapy

- **According to the next evaluation**, specific therapy prescriptions will be finalized.
- In the meantime, start **daily parent-guided routines (15–20 minutes)** focusing on joint attention, language enrichment, sequencing/turn-taking games, and self-regulation strategies to initiate intervention immediately.

Conclusion

This document reflects a developmental assessment. Aon is **capable of improvement** with prompt, consistent intervention and family engagement. Findings may evolve with progress and at the next in-person reassessment.
