

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Mahra Hilal Alzidi was assessed at our center as part of her ongoing developmental monitoring. She has shown **significant improvement following the first phase of intervention**. The child initially presented with **information processing delays and general developmental delays**, which had led to **acquired features of autism**. Variants were also identified that may be contributing to her developmental challenges.

Although progress is evident, Mahra continues to require **targeted support and further assessment** to guide the next phase of her developmental plan and address the underlying causes.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing (Non-Medicinal):

- Continue with a structured intervention protocol
- **Duration:** 3–4 months
- **Reevaluation:** Preferably in person after 3–4 months to establish a new baseline
- Continue adjusting the plan based on observed progress

2. Main Recommended Analysis (Next Evaluation):

Please refer to their report and assessment. These tests are not done at EICADD.

3. Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**
 - Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week
 - Start: After 2 months of the new step, based on progress and readiness

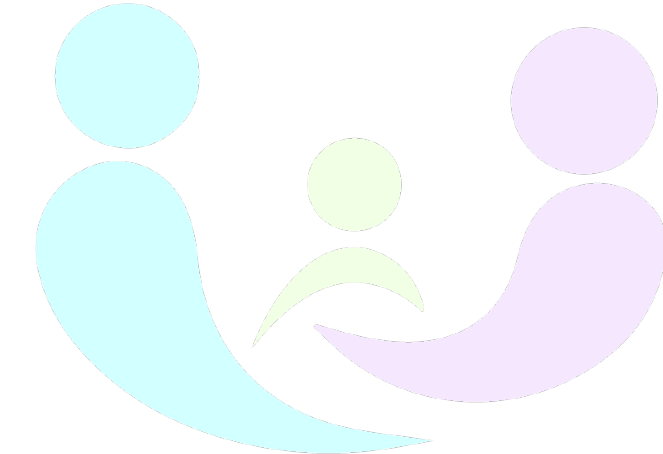
