### Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Saud visited our center for a developmental assessment. The evaluation indicated **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties**. Importantly, Saud does **not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) nor ADHD/ADD** at this time. He demonstrates the capability to attend school within a regular classroom setting, provided appropriate support strategies are in place. Further analyses are recommended to better understand the underlying factors.

### Recommended Plan:

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Duration: 4 months, followed by reassessment (preferably in person).
- Establish a new baseline during the reevaluation.
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan as needed.

#### 2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide.

#### 3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Occupational Therapy:** Intensive **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (to be initiated as soon as possible).
