

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Osama Abdullah was assessed at our center on 14-08-2025. The evaluation showed that the child has **information processing delays, global developmental delays, and intellectual developmental delays**. These delays have led to **acquired features of autism**, which require a targeted and structured intervention plan to maximize developmental progress.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing**
 - Duration: 4 months, followed by a reevaluation (preferably in person).
 - Objective: Reevaluate the plan, establish a new baseline, and continue with the intervention strategy tailored to the child's progress.
2. **Main Recommended Analyses:**
 - Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** – intensive, to be introduced in later stages when the child is ready for high-frequency sessions.

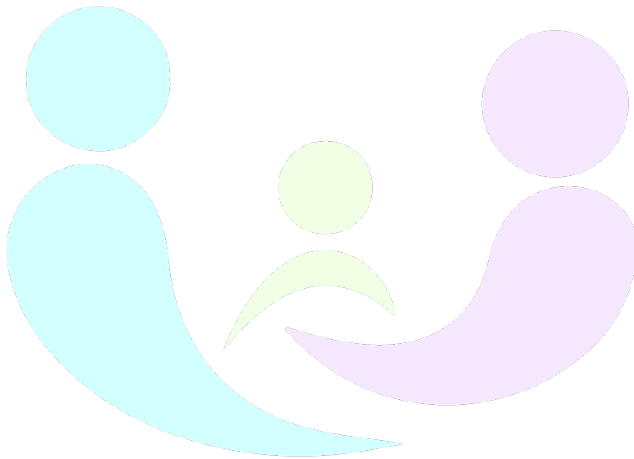
