Overview:

Touline attended our center for a developmental assessment on 02/08/2025.
The evaluation revealed:

- **Information Processing Delays**
- **Intellectual Developmental Delays**
- **Acquired Features of Autism** as a result of **variants affecting brain development and synaptic health**

Touline has **shown great improvement** since the initial intervention and demonstrates promising potential for continued progress with structured support.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the **development protocol for 4–6 months**.
- **Reevaluate in person** to establish a new baseline and monitor progress.
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan as necessary.

2) Main Recommended Analysis

- **Further analyses may be required** based on the next evaluation to better understand ongoing needs and optimize intervention strategies.

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3) Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** – Intensive, **to start in later stages** when the child is ready
- **Mitotherapy** – Intensive, **every couple of months**
- **Behavior and Occupational Therapy (OT)** – To be continued **either in Jordan or back in Saudi Arabia**

These therapies aim to **enhance cognitive processing, synaptic function, and overall developmental progress.**

Follow-Up

- **Reevaluation every 4–6 months** to track progress and adjust interventions.
- **Integration of future analysis results** for a more personalized developmental plan.


