Overview:

Taif was assessed at our center and presented with signs of information processing delays and developmental delays. These challenges have contributed to the development of hyperlexic features, particularly aligning with characteristics of Hyperlexia Type 2. Further investigation and structured intervention are required to support her developmental trajectory.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- o Begin an intensive support protocol over the next 4 months.
- o Conduct a reassessment, preferably in person, after this period.
- Establish a clear baseline and adjust the intervention as needed.

Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Recommended Therapy:

• Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:
