Overview:

Elaf was assessed at our center and presents with **information processing delays, intellectual developmental delays, and acquired features of autism**. These features are developmental in nature and appear to result from underlying physiological factors rather than a classical autism diagnosis. Further detailed analysis is required to identify the contributing causes and guide individualized therapeutic support.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing**
 - To be followed for 4 months
 - In-person reassessment is recommended after completion
 - Establish a baseline and adapt the plan based on observed progress
2. **Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):**
 - Please refer to their report and assessment.
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (Available in UAE or Jordan)

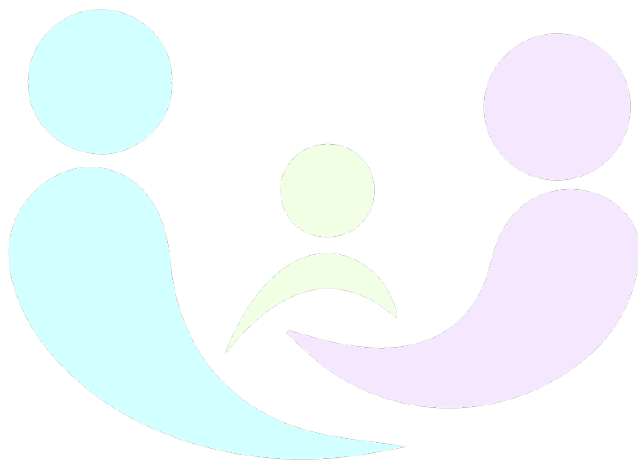
