Overview:

Ghaith was assessed at our center and found to have information processing delays and developmental delays, with current signs of Hyperlexia Type 1. At this stage, the profile has not yet progressed to Hyperlexia Type 2, and early intervention is necessary to help guide the child toward Hyperlexia Type 3, which is more communicative and functionally integrated. The child requires further assessment and close developmental monitoring.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person)
 - Establish a baseline of cognitive and language development
 - o Continue with the individualized developmental protocol
- 2. Recommended Laboratory Analyses (via Neurazon Reporting from Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and assessment. These tests are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - Continue with ongoing speech and occupational therapy
 - Start neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (2 sessions per week) as soon as possible
