Overview:

Rowad AlKhaizran visited our center for a comprehensive developmental assessment. During the evaluation, Rowad presented with information processing delays, developmental delays, and learning disabilities. These challenges are currently affecting his ability to perform at age-appropriate cognitive and academic levels. The observed delays are **not considered fixed**, and with the right intervention and analysis, significant improvement is possible. To support Rowad's growth and learning abilities, further analysis is needed to investigate the underlying causes contributing to his developmental profile.

Recommended Plan:





- Initiate a **development protocol** targeting information processing challenges.
- Duration: 4 months, after which the child will be reevaluated (preferably in person).
- The goal is to establish a baseline and adjust the intervention plan based on observed progress.
- Continue with the tailored intervention plan.

2) Main Recommended Analysis:

- Recommended through Canada: Precision Health Analysis Neurazon (Canada)
 - Purpose: A detailed analysis of the potential causes of developmental and learning delays.
 - Sample: Saliva sample
 - Turnaround Time: 4 months (business days) for results.
- Recommended through Canada: Neuronal Growth Factors Absorptions Analysis Neurazon (Canada)
 - 0 Purpose: Comprehensive analysis of the child's neuronal growth factors and their absorption status.
 - Sample: Hair sample
 - Turnaround Time: 2 months (business days) for results.
 - Frequency: Recommended every 6-12 months for progress monitoring.

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
Conclusion:
