Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Naji-A was assessed at our center on 03-09-2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to **hyperlexia, closer to hyperlexia type 2**. These findings reflect **acquired features of high-functioning autism**, though he does not meet the criteria for a full autism diagnosis. Further analyses are required to identify underlying causes and provide tailored interventions to optimize his development.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Implement a **4-month structured protocol** focusing on information processing.
- Conduct a **reevaluation after 4 months**, preferably in person.
- Establish a **baseline** during reevaluation for measurable progress.
- Continue with the intervention plan, adjusting as needed.

2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada)

The recommended analyses are provided through **Neurazon (Canada)**. These are **recommendations, not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly through our centers**. They are intended to complement therapy by providing deeper insight into developmental needs.

3) Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy:** Intensive sessions to **start immediately**, focusing on enhancing cognitive processing, communication, and adaptive skills.

Conclusion

Naji-A presents with **information processing delays, developmental delays, and hyperlexia closer to type 2**, associated with **acquired high-functioning autism features**. Early and intensive therapy, along with detailed analyses, will provide clarity on the underlying factors and support a more individualized plan for improvement. Reevaluation in 4 months is strongly advised.
