Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Deema visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation showed **information processing delays and developmental delays**, primarily affecting **early speech and communication development**. These delays are commonly seen in early childhood and may be influenced by a combination of physiological, developmental, and environmental factors.

At this stage, Deema does **not** show features of autism. However, the presence of early information processing delays means she will require structured developmental follow-up to support her speech and cognitive skills and to prevent future regression.

Further analysis may be required depending on her progress during the next phase of the developmental protocol.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin the non-medicinal developmental protocol targeting information processing.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by a reevaluation in person.
- Establish a new baseline at the next visit.
- Continue the intervention plan throughout the four months.

2) Recommended Tests (Through Neurazon – Canada)

At this stage, no tests are required immediately.

Further analyses (Precision Health or NGF Screening) may be recommended **upon reassessment**, depending on Deema's developmental progression.

3) Recommended Therapy

- **At-home developmental therapy**, including structured speech stimulation activities and daily parent-guided interaction routines.
- Techniques should focus on:
 - o Increasing verbal imitation
 - o Improving receptive language
 - Strengthening early communication pathways
 - Encouraging joint attention and naming

If progress is slower than expected, additional professional therapy may be introduced.

Notes on External Testing

The recommended tests, if required in the future, are conducted **through Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified international laboratories.

These tests are **optional**, external, and not performed directly through our center.

Parents may refer to the Neurazon plan for further details.
