Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Oday Al Hassan was assessed at our center on May 24th, 2025. The evaluation indicated the presence of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have contributed to traits leaning toward **hyperlexia**, closer to **Hyperlexia Type 2**, although he does not fully meet the criteria at this stage. Further analysis is necessary to better understand the underlying causes and to tailor an effective intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Implement the current development protocol for **4 months**.
 - o Reevaluate the child in person after this period to establish a new baseline.
 - o Continue adjusting the intervention based on observed progress.
- 2. Main Recommended Analysis:

These tests are recommended through Neurazon (Canada) and are not conducted directly through our center. Please refer to their test.

- 3. Recommended Therapy (to follow after identifying the causes):
 - o Mitotherapy therapy: 2–3 sessions per week.
 - o Neuroplasticity therapy: To be initiated in the later stages (available in UAE).
 - Occupational and Speech Therapy: 2 OT sessions + 2 ST sessions per week.
