## Overview

Abdullah visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. During the evaluation, Abdullah exhibited **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that are leading to **acquired features of autism**. It is important to highlight that this is not a definitive diagnosis, but an assessment of his current developmental stage. The findings emphasize the need for **further analysis** and continued monitoring to understand contributing factors and support his developmental trajectory. The child has hyperlexia like features.

## Recommended Plan

EICADD

### 1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Apply a **4-month protocol** targeting information processing.
- After 4 months, Abdullah should be **reevaluated in person**.
- Establish a **baseline** during the next assessment.
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan as needed.

### 2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada)
