

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Hayder was assessed online for developmental progress. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays and developmental delays**, with indications of **hyperlexia features closer to Type 3**, though not fully present. These findings are associated with **acquired features of high-functioning autism**; however, Hayder does **not score as a case of autism**.

Given the online nature of this assessment, a direct in-person evaluation is recommended in future follow-ups for a more accurate baseline.

Recommended Plan:

EICADD

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin a structured intervention protocol focused on information processing and comprehension.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
- Establish a baseline at that stage to refine and adjust the plan.
- Continue with progressive intervention protocols as needed.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - Frequency: Intensive therapy to start as soon as possible.
 - Focused on enhancing cognitive flexibility, literacy development, and adaptive learning skills.

Conclusion:

This is not a final diagnosis but a developmental evaluation. Hayder is capable of improvement, and with consistent therapy, structured interventions, and further biomedical analysis, progress is expected. A follow-up in person will provide a stronger baseline to continue optimizing the intervention plan.
