

Ostathna Center – Developmental Progress Assessment Report

Overview

Shko visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child has **improved greatly on the first protocol**, showing positive developmental changes. During today's evaluation, Shko demonstrated **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have contributed to the development of **hyperlexia-like features, closer to Hyperlexia Type 3**, though not fully meeting the criteria.

Previous analyses conducted externally through **Neurazon (Canada)** showed **genetic and developmental variants**, which explain the child's developmental trajectory and processing profile. The child **does not score as a case of autism**, but the acquired features observed are consistent with developmental delays influenced by biological factors. Further evaluation is required to continue guiding the intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for the next **4 months**, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
- Reassess progress and establish a new developmental baseline.
- Continue the structured, non-medicinal intervention plan to support information processing and cognitive development.

2) Recommended Tests Through Neurazon (Canada)

These tests are external and optional.

3) Recommended Therapy (After Determining the Causes)

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (intensive):**
Continue intensive visits **1–2 weeks every couple of months**, depending on progress and response.
- Additional cognitive and sensory-motor support may be added based on follow-up results.

Notes on External Testing

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These tests are **external, optional, and not performed directly through our center**.
